*Payment required at time of disposal*

**No dumping when gate is closed!**

Minimum \$10 fee for up to 200 lbs. of household waste or 400 lbs. of demolition waste, or 280 lbs. of mixed waste.

- **Demolition Waste** \$41.11 a ton
- **Household Waste** \$102.77 a ton
- **Tire Recycling** \$225.00 a ton
- **Tires with wheels** \$2.20 each additional cost

**FREE** disposal of the following items for all residents of Latah County:

- **Metals:** Washer, dryer, bicycles & scrap metal
  - **Yard Waste:** Branches/logs up to 10'x 26"
  - **Clean Wood:** Untreated lumber/pallets
  - **Hazardous Waste:** No commercial
- November - March: 1st Saturday of the month  
April - October: All Saturday's

### Obey All Signage

**24/7 Drop off:** tin/aluminum/steel, glass, #1 & #2 plastic bottles and jugs, cardboard, mixed paper, yard waste (less than 4'x 6"), motor or cooking oil (in a 5 gallon container or less). No, antifreeze.

### Accepted only during operating hours:

Electronic waste, rechargeable batteries, spiral CFL bulbs, ink/toner cartridges, bicycles and shredded paper.

**It is illegal to dump, burn or bury garbage.**

**Clean bags include;** plastic shopping, grocery, bread, produce, clear cereal/cracker bags, ice, dry cleaning, clean ziplok, salt, and wood pellet. Bubble wrap, air pillows, and case wrapping. Plastic wrap must be stretchable.

**No,** containers, or rigid, stiff, crinkly sounding or contaminated plastic.

## 2025 Holiday Service Schedule

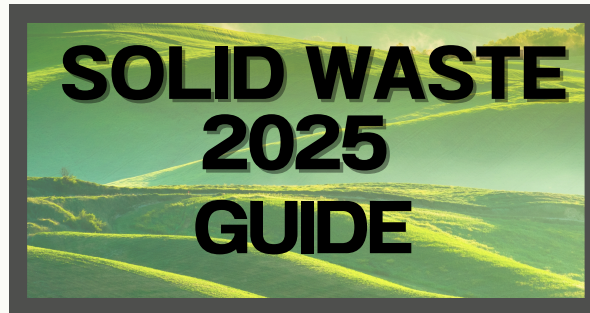
- **Memorial Day** all service one day late.

## Bulky Waste Site Guidelines

Free to Latah rural county and rural city residents paying for weekly service (details below). Questions call (208) 883-5706

- Property address and phone number required.
- Limit of 2 loads, per household per Saturday.
- Extremely large loads must use the Transfer Station site on 2nd & 4th Saturdays.
- **No**, hazardous/asbestos waste or liquid waste.
- **No**, computer monitors/TV's.
- **No**, dumping when sites are closed.
- **No**, commercial or City of Moscow use.

**Upholstered Furniture** - includes box springs and mattresses. **Accepted year round**

**Demolition Waste** - scrap metal, 4 passenger tires (no rims), 2 large appliances, sheetrock, tile, brick, porcelain, concrete, laminate flooring, renovated carpet/padding, glass windows, vinyl siding, wood furniture, untreated lumber and roofing materials.

**No, demolition accepted in April & October at Deary, Genesee, Juliaetta or Potlatch sites.**

**Household Waste** - all plastic or rubber items, hot tubs, glass, solidified latex paint, dishwashers, small appliances, microwaves, railroad ties, tents, tarps/canvas, CFL bulbs/tube lights, insulation, styrofoam, VCR's, stereos, upholstered furniture and contaminated waste.

**Household Waste ONLY accepted in April & October**

8:00am-4:00pm**

**Latah Rural Residents may use any site**

**Bovill: March 29th & August 30th** Railroad Ave

**Deary: 2nd & 4th Saturday's** Line St (behind elevators)

**Genesee: 2nd & 4th Saturday's** Morscheck Rd

**Juliaetta: 1st & 3rd Saturday's** Hwy 3 S. (past ballpark)

**Potlatch: 1st & 3rd Saturday's**

Turn at Depot onto Mill Rd to the Old Mill Site

**Troy/Rural Moscow: 2nd & 4th Saturday's**

Transfer Station, 3299 Hwy 8 E Moscow

## Weekly Collection Guidelines

Service provided by Sunshine Disposal to resolve service issues call 208 -743-4075

- Place cart at end of the driveway by 6:30 am.
- Ensure carts are not blocked or restricted.
- Allow a 3' open area around cart for service.
- Carts are serviced with a mechanical arm.
- Position cart with lid opening facing the roadway.
- Bag trash and close lids to prevent littering.
- Place extra bags/cans next to or on top of cart.
- Carts can be exchanged free of charge within 60 days for new owners or tenants.

## 2025 Rural Residential Fees

Fees are mandatory for occupied dwellings for weekly service, bulky waste sites, all recycling programs, hazardous waste and special events.

Cart Size	Quarterly	*Annual
32-Gallon	\$66.60	*\$261.40
64-Gallon	\$83.10	*\$327.40
96-Gallon	\$100.20	*\$395.80

**\*Annual fee is a \$5 savings if paid by 3/15/2025**

- Extra bag or can fee is \$5.40 for each item.
- Cart exchange fee \$19.76 (after 60 day trial).
- Cart replacement fee \$43.68.
- Accounts are billed quarterly. Payments are due by the 15th of March, June, September and December to avoid \$10 late fee.
- FREE monthly electronic payment is available.

## Latah Rural Recycling Guidelines

Dumpsters are serviced on Fridays

### Accepted Items

**Metals**- rinsed aluminum and tin/steel cans removed from plastic bags.

**Paper** items include newspapers, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, junk mail, phone books, and wrapping paper. **No**, hardback books.

- Remove all packaging
- Flatten all cardboard
- Do not leave recyclables on the ground

### Unacceptable Items:

**No**, Plastics, glass, pet food bags, foil, paper cartons, hazardous waste, TV's, computer monitors and hardback books.

### Recycling Bins located in:

- **Bovill** on Railroad Ave (across from City Hall)
- **Deary** on Line St. (near bulky waste site)
- **Genesee** on Morscheck Road (bulky waste site)
- **Juliaetta** on 3rd & Railroad
- **Kendrick** on 8th & Railroad (by yard waste bin)
- **Potlatch** at the City Hall parking lot
- **Troy** at the Sunset Mart parking lot

### Property owners / Managers

Property owners are responsible for all solid waste fees, if a tenant fails to pay. Delinquent fees may be certified to the owners property tax bill.
