Obey All Signage

24/7 drop off: glass, #1 & #2 plastic bottles
and jugs, cardboard, mixed paper, yard waste
(less than 4'x 6"), motor or cooking oil (in con-
tainer 5 gallons or less). No antifreeze.

Accepted only during operating hours:

Electronic waste, rechargeable batteries, spiral
CFL bulbs, ink/toner cartridges, bicycles and
shredded paper.

- All Latah County residents. No, commercial.

Plastic Bag/Film Recycling

At Moscow Recycling Center **accepted only on
the 1st Saturday** of every month 9:30am-5pm.

Clean bags include; shopping/grocery/bread/
produce/ice/dry cleaning/Ziploc/salt/wood pellet,
case wrap, air pillows, bubble wrap and plastic
film. No plastic containers.

Road Construction/Weather

If roads are impassable due to construction or
weather, extra trash will be serviced the following
week at no additional charge.

Landlords/Property Managers

Property owners are responsible for all Solid
Waste fees. If a tenant fails to pay, the property
owner is held responsible. Delinquent fees may
be certified to property taxes. Statements can be
mailed to the tenant, landlord or both. Tenants
may exchange the cart size within 60 days of
occupancy at no charge.

Latah County Bulky Waste

Is a free program for rural residents of Latah County (receiving weekly service). No waste from City of Moscow or commercial accounts.

Open Specified Saturday's 8am-4pm

Residents may use any site listed below

Bovill: April 29th & September 30th
Railroad Ave

Deary: 2nd & 4th Saturday's
Line St (behind elevators)

Genesee: 2nd & 4th Saturday's Morscheck Rd

Juliaetta: 1st & 3rd Saturday's
South on Hwy 3 (past the ball park)

Potlatch: 1st & 3rd Saturday's
Turn at Depot onto Mill Rd to the Old Mill Site

Troy/Moscow (landfill): 2nd & 4th Saturday's
3299 Hwy 8 E Moscow

No dumping when sites are closed!

See items accepted below

Demolition Waste includes: scrap metal, 2 large appliances, 4 passenger tires (no rims), drywall, concrete, tile, carpet, laminate flooring, porcelain, brick, untreated lumber and roofing materials. *Demolition is not accepted at rural city sites in April & October.*

Upholstered Furniture includes box springs and mattresses, excludes all plastic.

Accepted year round on specified Saturdays.

- Provide property address and phone number
- Limit of 2 loads, per household per Saturday
- Extremely large loads must use the Transfer Station site on 2nd & 4th Saturdays
- No hazardous or asbestos waste
- No computer monitors/TV's

Household Waste accepted only in

April & October includes; all plastic and rubber items, glass, old paint, small appliances, dishwashers, microwaves, railroad ties, tents, tarps/canvas, hot tubs, insulation, styrofoam, VCR's, stereos, and contaminated waste.

Latah Collection Guidelines

- Cart must be at end of driveway by 7am
- Carts or dumpsters cannot be blocked or restricted and
- Place extra bag/can next to or on top of the cart
- Closed lids and bagged trash will help prevent littering
- New homeowners or tenants may exchange the existing cart for a different size (35, 65 or a 95 gallon cart) free of charge within 60-days

Rural Residential Services

Mandatory fees provide weekly driveway service, recycling drop off, use of bulky waste sites, disposal of electronic, hazardous waste and special events for rural city and county residents.

For cart changes, fees, questions and concerns contact your City Clerk or Latah County Solid Waste. Those who reside within city limits are billed by the city.

Latah Rural Recycling

Metals: Rinsed aluminum, tin/steel cans.

Paper: Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, junk mail, phone books and wrapping paper. No hardback books.

Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags: Remove all packaging and flatten.

ACCEPTED ITEMS MUST BE SORTED

When in doubt, throw it out! Contamination increases cost and recyclables to be landfilled.

Unacceptable items: Plastics, glass, pet food bags, foil, paper cartons, hazardous waste, TV's, computer monitors and hard back books. *Visit Moscow Recycling Center for additional recycling options available.*
