Payment required at time of disposal

Minimum \$10 fee for up to 200 lbs of household waste, or 400 lbs of demolition waste, or 280 lbs of mixed waste

- **Demolition Waste:** \$41.73 per ton
- **Household Waste:** \$105.34 per ton
- **Tire Recycling:** \$325.00 per ton
- **Tires with Wheels:** \$2.20 additional cost each

Free disposal of the following items for ALL Latah County residents:

- **Metals:** Washer, dryer, bicycles, tin, iron, brass, copper, and steel.
- **Yard Waste:** Branches and logs up to 6' long by 24" diameter
- **Hazardous Waste:** No commercial
November-March: 1st Saturday of the month
April-October: All Saturdays
- **Clean Wood:** Untreated lumber/pallets

Accepted only during operating hours:

- Electronic waste and rechargeable batteries
- Spiral CFL bulbs
- Ink/toner cartridges
- Bicycles
- Shredded paper

24/7 Drop Off:

- Tin, aluminum, steel and glass
- #1 or #2 plastic bottles and jugs
- Cardboard, mixed paper
- Yard waste (less than 4'x6")
- Motor or cooking oil (in a 5 gallon container or less) **NO ANTIFREEZE**

- **All** Latah County residents. **No** commercial.

Tire Amnesty Day May 30th

- 8am-4pm at the Transfer Station and *Latah County rural city bulky waste sites
*Rural bulky waste sites will **ONLY** accept tires
- Free tire disposal for **ALL** Latah County residents
- Passenger vehicle tires only. **No** commercial
- **No** rims, tractor or semi truck tires
- Haul extremely large loads to the Transfer Station

Plastic Bag/Film Recycling

1st Saturday of every month 9:30am-5pm

Clean bags include: shopping, grocery, bread, produce, ice, dry cleaning, Ziploc, salt, wood pellet, case wrapping, air pillows, bubble wrap, and *stretchable* plastic film.

No rigid, stiff, crinkly sounding, or contaminated plastic. **No** containers.

2026 Holiday Service Schedule

- **Memorial Day** - all service one day late
- **Labor Day** - all service one day late
- **Thanksgiving Day** - Thursday service will be one day late

*Service days will **not** change for all other holidays.*

Road Construction/Weather

Free to Latah rural county and rural city residents paying for weekly service.

Open Specified Saturdays 8am-4pm

Latah Rural Residents may use any site

Bovill: May 30th & August 29th

Railroad Ave

Deary: 2nd & 4th Saturdays

Line St (behind elevators)

Genesee: 2nd & 4th Saturdays Morscheck Rd

Juliaetta: 1st & 3rd Saturdays (*Closed July 4th*)

South on Hwy 3 (past the ball park)

Potlatch: 1st & 3rd Saturdays (*Closed July 4th*)

Turn at Depot onto Mill Rd to the Old Mill Site

Troy/Moscow: 2nd & 4th Saturdays

Transfer Station-3299 Hwy 8 E Moscow

- Property address & phone number required
- Limit 2 loads per household per Saturday
- Extremely large loads must use the Transfer Station site on 2nd & 4th Saturdays
- **NO** hazardous/asbestos or liquid waste, monitors/TV's, or rechargeable batteries

Demolition Waste Items

Not accepted April & October at the Deary, Genesee, Juliaetta or Potlatch sites
Only accepted on specified Saturdays

- 4 passenger tires (no rims)
- 2 large appliances, scrap metal (BBQ/bicycles)
- Sheetrock, glass windows, doors (no vinyl)
- Tile, brick, concrete, roofing materials
- Renovated carpet/padding, laminate flooring
- Wood furniture, untreated lumber, tree stumps

Household Waste Items

Only accepted April & October on specified Saturdays

- All plastic/rubber items, contaminated waste
- Hot tub, solidified latex paint/empty paint cans
- Dishwashers, small household appliances
- Railroad ties/treated lumber, new carpet
- Insulation, styrofoam, fiberglass, vinyl
- Upholstered furniture, box spring and mattresses accepted year round
- Tents, tarps, canvas, CFL/all light bulbs

Weekly Collection Guidelines

Service provided by Sunshine Disposal. To resolve service issues call (208) 743-4075.

- Place cart at the end of the driveway by 6:30 am.
- Ensure carts are not blocked or restricted.
- Allow a 3' open area around cart for service to be provided.
- Carts are serviced with a mechanical arm.
- Position cart with lid opening facing the roadway.
- Bag trash and close lid to prevent littering.
- Place extra bags/cans next to or on top of cart.
- Carts can be exchanged FREE of charge within 60 days for new owners or tenants. After 60-day trial there is a fee.
- Fees are billed for extra bags or cans.
- Please call for driveway service details.

2026 Rural Residential Services

Fees are mandatory for occupied dwellings. Fees cover weekly service, use of bulky waste sites, all recycling programs, hazardous/electronic waste disposal, and special events.

All accounts within the rural city limits are billed by the city. Contact the City Hall you reside in for cart changes, fees and billing questions. Each rural city implements a fee schedule for services within the community.

ACCEPTED ITEMS

Metals: Rinsed aluminum, tin/steel cans
Paper: Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, junk mail, phone books and wrapping paper. **No** hardback books.

Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags:

- Remove all packaging
- Flatten all cardboard
- Please **do not** leave recyclables on the ground

Unacceptable items: Plastics, glass, pet food bags, foil, paper cartons, hazardous waste, TVs, computer monitors and hard back books. Visit Moscow Recycling Center for additional recycling options available.

When in doubt, throw it out! Contamination increases cost and recyclables to be landfilled
