**Obey All Signage**

**24/7 drop off:** glass, #1 & #2 plastic bottles and jugs, cardboard, mixed paper, yard waste (less than 4'x 6"), motor or cooking oil (in a 5 gallon container or less). No antifreeze.

**Accepted only during operating hours:**

Electronic waste, rechargeable batteries, spiral CFL bulbs, ink/toner cartridges, bicycles and shredded paper.

- All Latah County residents. No, commercial

## Tire Amnesty Day June 29, 2024

\*Rural Bulky Waste Sites will ONLY accept tires

- Free tire disposal for Latah County residents
- Passenger vehicle tires only. No commercial
- No rims, tractor or semi truck tires
- Accepted 8am-4pm at the Transfer Station, and Latah County \*rural city Bulky Waste Sites
- Extremely large loads haul to Transfer Station

## Plastic Bag/Film Recycling

At Moscow Recycling Center **accepted only on the 1st Saturday** of every month 9:30am-5pm.

Clean bags include; shopping/grocery/bread/produce/ice/dry cleaning/Ziploc/salt/wood pellet, case wrap, air pillows, bubble wrap and plastic film. No plastic containers.

## Road Construction/Weather

If roads are impassable due to construction or weather, extra trash will be serviced the following week at no additional charge.

## 2024 Holiday Service Schedule

- Memorial Day, all service one day late
- Independence Day, Thursday service will be one day late
- Labor Day, all service one day late
- Thanksgiving Day, Thursday service will be one day late
- Christmas Day, Wednesday and Thursday service will be one day late
- 2025 New Year's Day, Wednesday and Thursday service will be one day late

Latah County Solid Waste (LCSW) is responsible for coordinating waste removal under state and federal laws.

Latah County Solid Waste (LCSW) is contracted with Sunshine Disposal for collection of waste, and with City of Moscow, for disposal of waste.

## Bulky Waste Site Guidelines

Free to Latah rural county and rural city residents paying for weekly service (schedule below). Excludes commercial and City of Moscow.

**Call with questions (208) 883-5706**

- Property address and phone number required
- Limit 2 loads, per household per Saturday
- Extremely large loads must use the Transfer Station site on 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays
- No hazardous/asbestos waste or liquid waste
- No computer monitors/TV's

**Upholstered Furniture** - includes box springs and mattresses, excludes all plastic.

**Accepted year round**

**Demolition Waste** - scrap metal, 4 passenger tires (no rims), 2 large appliances, drywall, tile, concrete, carpet, laminate flooring, renovated carpet/padding, glass windows porcelain, brick, untreated lumber and roofing materials.

**Demolition not accepted in April & October**

**Household Waste** - all plastic and rubber items, hot tubs, glass, old solidified paint, small appliances, dishwashers, microwaves, railroad ties, tents, tarps/canvas, insulation, styrofoam, VCR's, stereos, and contaminated waste.

**Household Waste only accepted in April & October**

*Morscheck Rd*

**Juliaetta:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday's

*South on Hwy 3 (past the ball park)*

**Potlatch:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday's

*Turn at Depot onto Mill Rd to the Old Mill Site*

**Troy/Rural Moscow:** 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday's

*Transfer Station, 3299 Hwy 8 E*

*No dumping when sites are closed*

## Weekly Collection Guidelines

**Service provided by Sunshine Disposal to resolve service issues call 208 743 4075**

- Place cart at end of driveway by 6:30am
- Carts cannot be blocked or restricted
- Carts are serviced with a mechanical arm
- Place cart with lid opening towards roadway
- Bag trash and closed lids prevent littering
- Place extra bag/can next to or on top of the cart
- Carts may be exchanged free of charge within 60-days for new owners or tenants

## Rural Residential Services

Fees are mandatory for occupied dwellings for weekly driveway service, recycling programs, bulky waste sites, disposal of electronic, hazardous waste and special events for rural city and county residents.

All accounts within rural city limits are billed by the city the property addresses is within. Contact the City Hall you reside within for cart changes, fees and billing questions. Each Rural cities adopts fees schedules for services and city ordinances.

## Latah Rural Recycling

**Accepted items listed no longer need to be sorted. Sunshine Disposal services recycling dumpsters every Friday.**

*We are modifying dumpsters for materials accepted to eliminate the contamination of garbage and plastic bags so items collected can be recycled.*

**Metals-** Rinsed aluminum, tin/steel cans. Must be removed from any plastic bag.

**Paper-** Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, junk mail, phone books and wrapping paper. No hardback books.

**Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags-** Remove all packaging and flatten.

**Unacceptable items-** No, Plastics, glass, pet food bags, foil, paper cartons, hazardous waste, TV's, computer monitors and hard back books.

*When in doubt, throw it out!*
