## Tire Amnesty Day July 30, 2022

- Free tire disposal for Latah County residents
- Passenger vehicle tires only. No commercial
- No rims, tractor or semi truck tires
- Accepted at 8am-4pm at the Transfer Station,  
Moscow Recycling Center and Latah County  
\*rural city Bulky Waste Sites
- Extremely large loads haul to Transfer Station

**\*Rural City Bulky Waste Sites  
will ONLY accept Tires\***

## Plastic Bag/Film Recycling

Moscow Recycling Center **accepted only on the  
1st Saturday** of every month 9:30am-5pm

Clean bags include; shopping/grocery/bread/  
produce/ice/dry cleaning/Ziploc/salt/wood pellet,  
case wrap, air pillows, bubble wrap and plastic  
film. No plastic containers.

## Road Construction / Weather

If roads are impassable due to construction or  
weather, extra trash will be serviced the following  
week at no additional charge.

## Landlords/Property Managers

Property owners are responsible for all Solid  
Waste fees. If a tenant fails to pay, the property  
owner is held responsible. Delinquent fees may  
be certified to property taxes. Statements can be  
mailed to the tenant, landlord or both. Tenants may  
exchange the cart size within 60 days of occupancy  
at no charge.

## Bulky Waste Program

For rural city and residential accounts of Latah County. Rural city sites will accept household waste only in April & October. Not for City of Moscow residents and no commercial.

- Property address and phone number required
- No E-waste, computer monitors and TV's, must be taken to Moscow Recycling Center
- No hazardous or asbestos waste
- Limit of 2 loads, per household per Saturday
- Extremely large loads must use the Transfer Station on 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays

**Demolition Waste** includes: scrap metal, 2 large appliances, 4 passenger tires (no rims), drywall, concrete, tile, carpet, laminate flooring, porcelain, brick, untreated lumber and roofing materials. **Not accepted in April & October at rural city sites.**

**Household Waste** includes; all plastic / rubber material items, small appliances, railroad ties, contaminated waste, tents, insulation, styrofoam, fiberglass, hot tubs, tarps/canvas. **Only accepted in April & October at sites.**

**Upholstered Furniture** including box springs and mattresses **accepted year round on specified Saturday's.**

**Bovill:** April 30<sup>th</sup> & October 29<sup>th</sup> only  
Railroad Ave

**Deary:** 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday's  
Line St (behind elevators)

**Genesee:** 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday's  
Morscheck Road

**Julietta:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday's  
South on Hwy 3 (past the ball park)

**Potlatch:** 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday's

South of City Hall on Rock Creek

**Troy/Moscow (landfill):** 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday's  
3299 Hwy 8 E Moscow

## Collection Guidelines

- Place cart at end of driveway by 7am
- Waste must be bagged and lids closed
- Carts cannot be blocked or restricted
- Place extra bag/can next to your cart

### Rural Residential Service

Mandatory fees provide weekly driveway service, special events, recycling drop off, use of bulky waste sites and hazardous waste drop off for rural city and county residents.

For cart changes, fees, questions or concerns contact your City Clerk or Latah County Solid Waste. Those who reside within city limits are billed by the city.

## Rural Recycling Program

*162 tons collected in 2021 from rural drop off sites*

**Metals:** Rinsed aluminum, tin/steel cans

**Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, junk mail, phone books and wrapping paper. No hardback books.

**Cardboard/Brown Paper Bags:** Remove all packaging and flatten

*ACCEPTED ITEMS MUST BE SORTED*

*When in doubt, throw it out! Contamination increases cost and recyclables to be landfilled.*

**Unacceptable items:** Plastics, glass, pet food bags, foil, paper cartons, hazardous waste, TV's, computer monitors and hard back books

### Recycling Bins located in:

**Bovill** on Railroad Ave (across from City Hall)

**Deary** on Line St. (near the bulky waste site)

**Genesee** on Morscheck Road

**Julietta** on 3<sup>rd</sup> & Railroad

**Kendrick** on 8<sup>th</sup> & Railroad (by yard waste bin)

**Potlatch** at the City Hall parking lot

**Troy** at the Sunset Mart parking lot

#### *Obey All Signage*

**24/7 drop off:** glass, #1 & #2 plastic bottles and jugs, cardboard, mixed paper, yard waste (less than 4'x 6"), motor or cooking oil (in container 5 gallons or less). No antifreeze.

**Accepted only during operating hours:**

Electronic waste, rechargeable batteries, spiral CFL bulbs, ink/toner cartridges, bicycles and shredded paper.
