

ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOVILL, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING OF SIXTH STREET FROM PINE STREET TO SPRUCE STREET; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY SHALL RETAIN A TWENTY-FOOT WIDE UTILITY EASEMENT DOWN THE CENTER OF THE VACATED STREET; PROVIDING THAT TITLE TO SAID VACATED RIGHT-OF-WAY SHALL VEST WITH THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTIES ON EACH SIDE OF SIXTH STREET DIVIDED BY THE CENTER LINE OF SIXTH STREET; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, the owners of adjacent properties have petitioned the City for the vacating of a portion of the Sixth Street right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of June, 1993, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the matter of vacating a portion of the Sixth Street right-of-way and determined that such action was in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOVILL AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the following described street right-of-way be, and the same hereby is, vacated as of the effective date of this Ordinance:

All of that portion of Sixth Street lying between and being contiguous to Pine Street to Spruce Street, original Bovill town site, said property being within the City of Bovill, Latah County, Idaho; providing however, that the City retains a utility easement as described herein.

SECTION 2: That the City of Bovill retains a twenty-foot wide utility easement down the center of the vacated right-of-way. Owners may not build within this easement.

SECTION 3: That ownership of the above-described property be, and the same hereby is, granted to the owners of the property adjacent to the vacated right-of-way on each side of Sixth Street with the property dividing line being the former center line of Sixth Street.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

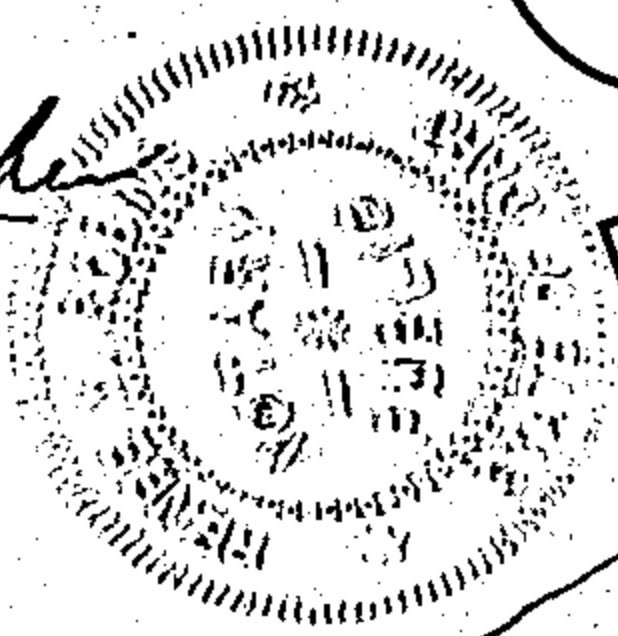
