

**ORDINANCE NO 235 2021-04**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BOVILL, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF FEES FOR NEW CONNECTIONS TO THE WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS, AND WATER METER REPLACEMENT CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR THIS ORDINANCE TO BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER SEPTEMBER 7<sup>TH</sup> 2021**

**WHEREAS**, the city council of the city of Bovill finds the recent improvements, inflation and other factors have increased the costs of the water and sewer systems, and finds that establishment of adjusted rates are necessary for the orderly growth and development within the city and impact area, and will further the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and all Bovill citizens;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOVILL AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. WATER CONNECTIONS:**

- A. The connection fee for water service from the city water system shall be \$1500.00
- B. Additional installation costs will be charged for all materials and labor (\$75.00 per hour)

**SECTION 2. SEWER CONNECTIONS:**

- A. The connection fee for sewer service from the city sewer system shall be \$1000.00.
- B. Additional installation costs will be charged for all materials and labor (75.00 per hour)

**SECTION 3. DEDICATED FUNDS:**

Water and sewer connection fees shall be placed in a dedicated fund and utilized only for capital improvements to the water and sewer systems, including replacement of existing ones.

**SECTION 4. WATER METER REPLACEMENT:**

Faulty water meters will be replaced by city maintenance personnel only, at no fee to the property owner unless the meter is damaged due to neglect of the property owner or the plumbing. A fee of \$115.00 plus labor and materials will be charged to the property owner for damage due to property owner neglect or plumbing. The meter remains the property of the City of Bovill.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication according to the law

**WHEREAS**, In the future, any type of water and sewer rate changes may be made by resolution

PASSED by the city council and APPROVED by the Mayor on this 4<sup>th</sup> Day of October of 2021
